

Preparing to obtain EMT card and employment at San Luis Ambulance (SLA)

1. Get CPR trained for BLS (healthcare provider only)

2. Take a National Registry of Emergency Medical Technician (NREMT) approved EMT class.

4. Register with the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technician (NREMT) in order to sign up for the written test

5. Before scheduling an examination appointment, you must have already:
 - ✓ Registered with The National Registry and received an Authorization to Test (ATT) letter.
 - ✓ Been notified of your eligibility to sit for the examination; and
 - ✓ Paid an examination authorization fee to The National Registry.
6. Once you have passed the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technician (NREMT) test you now need to apply for your EMT card from the local Emergency Medical Services Agency (EMSA).

7. Live scan finger printing is needed for a background check for San Luis Obispo National Registry of Emergency Medical Technician.

8. Form for Live scan from San Luis Obispo National Registry of Emergency Medical Technician.

NOTE: A copy of valid government issued ID card is needed with the application.

9. Pay the fee of \$104.00 to the San Luis Obispo National Registry of Emergency Medical Technician. Processing time may be lengthy so do this ASAP.
10. To get an Ambulance Driver's Certificate from the Department of Motor Vehicle (DMV) you will need to know:
 - ✓ Have a valid County issued EMT card.
 - ✓ Be at least 18 years of age.
 - ✓ Hold a Driver License that is valid in California.
 - ✓ Visit a DMV office (appointments are recommended).
 - ✓ Pay an application fee.
 - ✓ \$25 for an original certificate.
 - ✓ Pass an Ambulance Driver Certification examination.

11. Submit a completed Request for Live Scan Service Application (DMV 8016).

NOTE: Not required on renewal applications
